
*The Conquest of the South Pole*

Four unemployed Rumford Maine mill workers at the very edge of despair concoct an innovative way to empower themselves amidst the hardships of their lives. Led by their magnetic leader Slupianek (Ian Carlsen), they reenact, in an attic crowded with discarded furniture and hanging sheets, Amundsen's successful conquest of the South Pole, in order to face, and hopefully conquer, their own demons.



The *Guardian* called *The Conquest of the South Pole* a "vivid, achingly alive play," while The Chicago Critic described it as "a spirited, often funny journey of desperation with loads of heart...filled with humor, wit and a child-like playfulness."


