Under the sure guidance of Master Storyteller Chris Newcomb, *Think You Might Be Wrong* explores, through the telling of several tales that are sometimes comic, sometimes comically painful, and always surprising, the ways in which we are right, wrong, and even wrong about being wrong! This new play aims to make you think twice, or even thrice, about everything you think you believe, and when that happens, a certain open-minded magic unfolds.

Think You Might Be Wrong was written by and stars Chris Newcomb. Several of Chris' art pieces will also be featured in the show, and for sale in the lobby! The play was developed with Snowlion Rep and will be directed by Artistic Director Al D'Andrea, as a co-production with ARTernatives.


